Themed Libraries

Woodland-themed libraries

The Woodland theme includes a Storytelling Table with a woodland picture on the table top - a perfect starting point for storytelling or creative writing. The design also includes tree-shaped PC desking and little toadstool seats as well as wall stickers in the form of trees, leaves and birds. Children can write on the leaves and wipe off again - a great way of engaging reluctant writers.

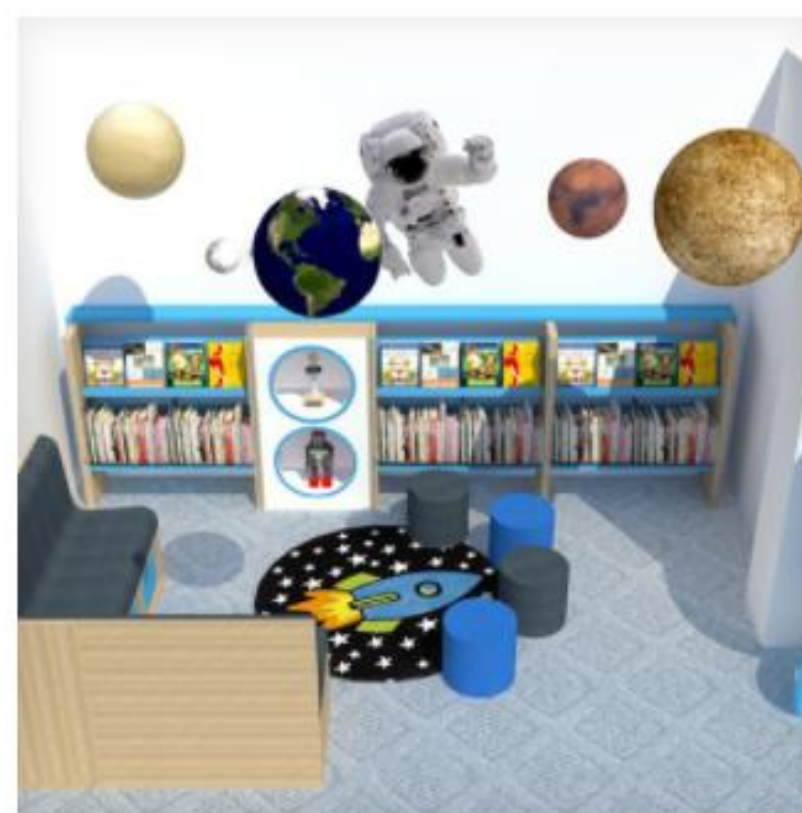

Jungle-themed libraries

The Jungle-theme provides lots of opportunities for children to curl up with a book. Elephant stools, vine-adorned Hideyholes and leaf canopies suspended from the ceiling providing lots of cosy spaces. Tall giraffe panels at the end of the shelving units and elephant-shaped bookshelves are used to add the 'wow' factor to your library.

Space-themed libraries

The space-themed design includes replica planets hanging from the ceiling, which gives children a fun way to experience the wonders of the Solar System. We also include space-themed bean bags, a Rocket Hideyhole, space-themed wall stickers and a Rocket Pod which makes a great feature unit with fun mirror circles and tactile Solar-System beads on the sides.

圖書排架方式

- 按索書號排列

- 面對書架，由左而右，由上而下排列

- 索書號

- 特藏號『R』是指參考書

- 分類號，依圖書之內容主題，給予對應之類號

- 作者號，區別不同作者之著作

- 年代號，著錄圖書之出版年

- 部冊號，分為冊次號與部次號，冊次號是為區別分冊之圖書，例如 v.1, v.2 分別指第一冊(上冊)與第二冊(下冊)，而部次號是用以區分相同版本之圖書，例如 c.3, c.5 分別指第三本與第五本複本書。
